Hospice Day Program Eligibility

- ❑ You are living with a life threatening illness.
- ❑ You are looking for support and/or your family needs respite.
- ❑ You are cognitively oriented and agree to attend Day Program.
- ❑ You can manage your own medication.
- ❑ You are not bedridden and can ambulate on your own or with a walker or wheelchair.

⇒ Bobby's Hope House is wheelchair accessible. Walkers and canes should have your name on them.

⇒ It is important that you bring your own medication and any equipment that assists you.

⇒ We take pictures at Day Program for our Memorial Book and promotional purposes. You have a right to choose whether you want to be included in media articles or photos.

⇒ Space at Day Program is limited. Call Sue King, R.N., at 648-6608 to register and confirm your attendance.
